

The following are some of the key highlighted activities from the SSEA ED in the 2023 Q2.

Budget/Financial/Fundraising

- Researching/identifying grant and fundraising opportunities.
- \$1,600 raised (donation) by Perkinsfield pop-up fundraiser (Meg Whitton Bounce 104.1)



Outreach/ Networking/Partners

As the ED, one of my key roles is to build and maintain partner and external relationships as part of regular environmental scan of issues and opportunities.

- Government Relations Maintained relationships with MPPs and MPs
- Follow-up meeting with MP Chambers re: Federal budget commitment to Great Lakes
- Represented Severn Sound communities at the Great Lakes St Lawrence Cities Initiative (GLSLCI) AGM in Chicago – 50% of travel and attendance cost covered by Township of Tiny.
 - Networked and discussed climate adaptation strategies with Mayors, Municipal Councillors and staff from municipalities around the Great Lakes
 - Accepted WEGE small community's sustainability award on behalf of the Township of Tiny
 - Working on idea of local Georgian Bay mini GLSLCI with GLSLCI staff and Georgian Bay mayors who attended including Town of Blue Mountains, Collingwood, Owen Sound and Township of Archipelago
- Met with Linda Rodenburg, Principal at Lakehead University Orillia, exploring partnership opportunities.
- Partnering with the County of Simcoe for SSEA website update and transition, significant cost savings by partnering with the County and thank you to County staff for support through the migration.
